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### Smart Schools Bond Act (SSBA) Overview



#### About the Smart Schools Bond Act of 2014



- The Smart Schools Bond Act (SSBA) was passed in the 2014 15
   Enacted Budget and approved by the voters in a statewide
   referendum on Nov. 4, 2014.
- The SSBA authorized the issuance of \$2 billion of bonds to finance improved educational technology and infrastructure.
- The intent of the SSBA is to improve current learning opportunities for NYS K12 students as well as future employment potential in the 21st Century job market.

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#### About the Smart Schools Bond Act of 2014 (cont.)



- The SSBA provides funds for three specific areas:
  - Instructional technology including devices
  - o Technology infrastructure & connected systems incl. high-tech Security features
  - Temporary classroom upgrades to permanent structures
- The SSBA requires that a Review Board review and approve districts' **Smart Schools Investment Plans (SSIPs)** before any funds are made available.
- SSIPs are developed by a **District's SSIP team** based on current conditions and the District's five-year objectives.
- Onondaga Central School District is eligible for \$800,506.



Each goal will require one (or more) individual technology plans based on funding sources. The Smart Schools Investment Plan (SSIP) summarized here is to obtain the district's SSBA allocation from the State.

This is the **only SSIP** that OCSD will submit to the SED for the district's total \$800,506 Smart Schools Bond Act allocation.

#### **Current Conditions**

- Establish industry standard Technology Rooms and Backbone infrastructure.
- Upgrade Cabling and Network Electronics to provide reliable and pervasive wireless network services throughout the district.
