From the New York State Department of Health:

- Testing for COVID-19 If you develop symptoms such as fever, cough, and/or difficulty breathing, and have been in close contact with a person known to have COVID-19 or have recently traveled from an area with ongoing spread of COVID-19, stay home and call your doctor.
- If you are older, have severe underlying medical conditions, or are immunocompromised, call your doctor early, even if your illness is mild.
- In an emergency call 911.
- Your doctor will determine if you have signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and order the test if needed.
- If you do not have a doctor and have questions, symptoms, or may have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, call Upstate University Hospital's Triage Line at 315.464.3979 you will be advised about testing. The line is open 24 hours.
