PROPOSED BUDGET 2024-2025

Onondaga Central Schools

Dear Stakeholders,
We are excited to announce that on May 21, 2024, residents of the Onondaga Central School District will have the opportunity to vote on a proposed budget of \$26,700,588 for the upcoming 2024-2025 school year. As a community, we have recognized our ability to confront challenges, ensuring that our students can achieve their fullest potential and emerge as valuable contributors to society.

The proposed budget represents a 3.45% increase (\$880,800) over the previous school year. Of this increase, \$17,100 will be covered by the proposed property tax increase, while the remaining \$863,700 will be sourced from other revenues, including New York State Aid. This budget allocation is designed to sustain our existing programs and uphold small class sizes, fostering an environment conducive to effective learning.

To support these objectives, the proposed budget includes a 2.2% overall tax rate increase. This increase will enable us to maintain essential resources such as educational programs, safety protocols, professional development, and health insurance expenses. Our proposed tax rate increase of 2.2% falls within the maximum tax rate limit permissible under the cap law. The proposed tax rate increase is estimated to result in an additional cost of \$3 cents per \$1000 of assessed value for landowners in the Town of Onondaga.

Even though we did not see a large increase in state aid as in previous years, we are proud to be one of the lowest tax increases in the state. Over the past decade, district residents have seen an average annual tax increase of approximately 0.56%, a testament to our commitment to fiscal responsibility. The 2024-2025 budget priorities continue to include:
